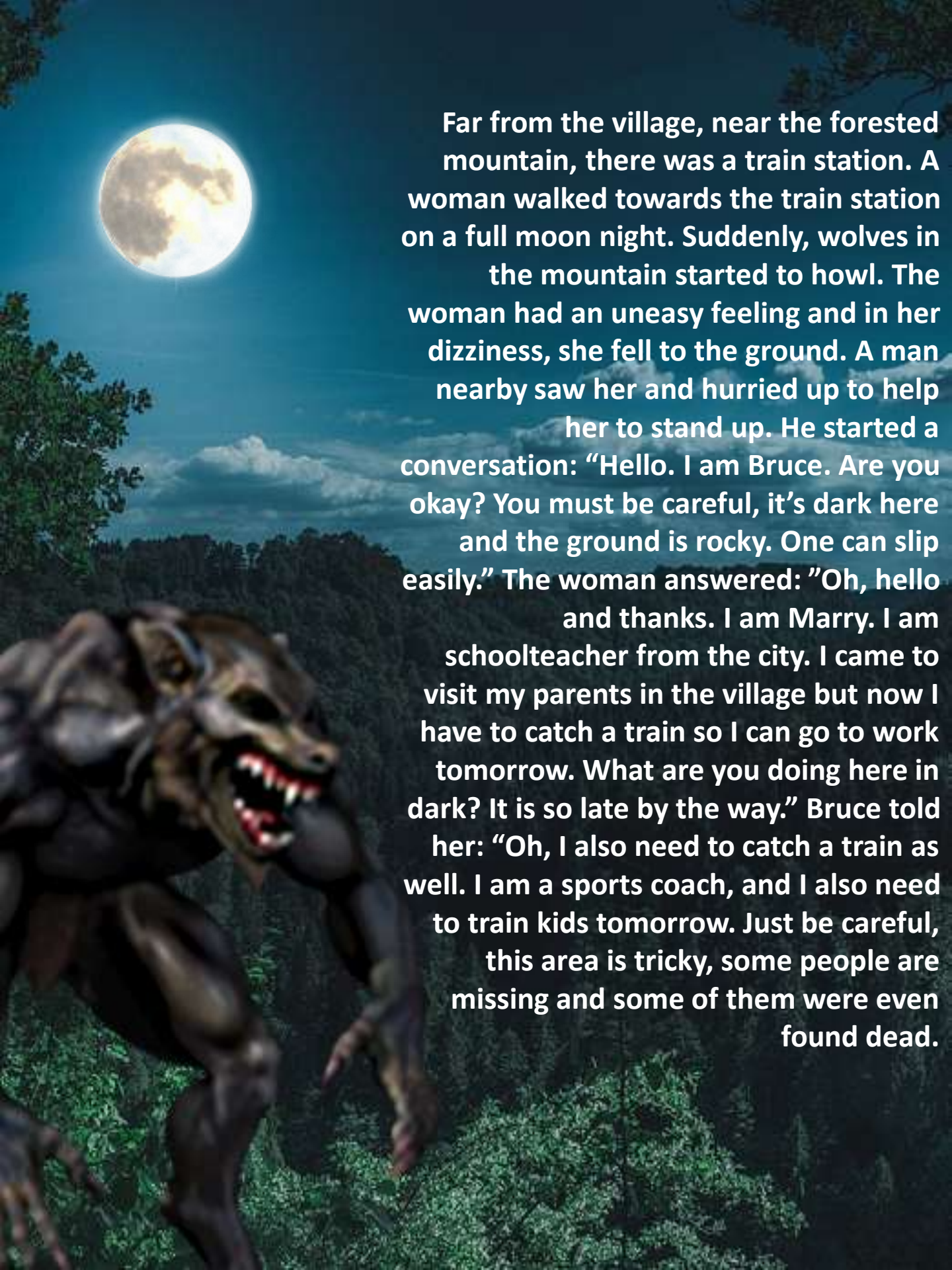


NIGHT TRAIN
